Pageant Pre-Qualification Checklist

In order to participate in the pageant, you must meet the following criteria:

- ✓ United States citizen or lawful permanent resident
- ✓ High school senior girl, attending school within the Porterville school districts (home school included)
- ✓ Cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher
- ✓ Of good moral character
- ✓ Unmarried and without children



Estimated Expenses

- ★ Spirit dance costume \$30 \$50
- ★ New Court Formal Dress (if selected for the court) \$600 - \$900
 - This cost can be covered by the sponsorship money that each contestant will be responsible for acquiring. It does NOT have to come out of pocket. This dress will be the "uniform" of the court during the entire year.
- ★ Purchasing a <u>pageant</u> formal (to be worn the night of the pageant) is <u>an unnecessary expense</u>. We recommend reusing one that you already have or borrowing one.

Sponsorship

It will be required for you to find at least 1 sponsor (you may have up to 5) to give you a \$250 donation. The sponsor (local business, family friend, etc.) would write two checks: \$50 to the Veterans Homecoming Committee who is organizing the event, and \$200 to you, the contestant, to help cover the pageant expenses listed above.
